Proceedings:

• *Meeting called to order* at 11 a.m. by President, Dr. Gwen Johnson Green

• Vice President, Callie Hammond, moved to approve the minutes from the January 29th meeting, Preston Waddell second the motion, the motion carried unanimously

· President's Welcome:

- Dr. Johnson Green welcomed the 2013 NCAAE Board and guests. Dr. Johnson expressed her excitement that the association has finally

reorganized and commented that the association had not come together since 2008. Dr. Johnson reviewed the agenda and started by re-introducing Board Member, Ken Gattis, the DPI liaison.

Finance Committee report provided by President, Dr. Johnson Green: - Noted by Dr. Johnson Green that we would be unable to have a treasurer's report, due to Mr. Richard Armstrong 's absence.

- Board member, Ken Gattis, discussed the DPI Standards Document. Gattis noted that the standards were developed in 2007 and have not been revised since. The standards listed in the document were a result of a statue that was passed by the North Carolina Board of Education. Gattis commented on one of the newest statutes added to standards - *If a principal is going to long-term suspend a student, they have to provide an alternative setting unless there is a compelling reason not to*. Dr. Johnson advised that we form a committee to review and revise the standards.(Please use this link to view the DPI Standards http://www.dpi.state.nc.us/alp/develop/)
- Ken Gattis turned the floor over to current NCAAE Historian and former NCAAE President, Valoria Burch. Burch further explained the origination of the DPI standards. Burch noted the main portion of the document focuses on 37 quality indicators. Burch said that if your school follows these indicators it should be considered an effective alternative school. Burch noted the #22 indicator received the most push-back from superintendents across the state. This indicator has to do with the % of the E.C. population within an alternative school. It states that the % of the E.C. population within the alternative school should never exceed that of the referring school's overall %. Burch also clarified Gattis's role within NCAAE -Gattis will share any DPI updates relating to alternative schools and will also communicate those updates to all NC school districts. Burch mentioned that the current DPI standards are based on research from other states and aligns with the National Standards. She recommended that each board member visit Tennessee's Alternative Education Standards as well as the National Standards.

- Membership Board Member Sonia Jordan-English stated that a committee, headed by Valoria Burch, needs to review the current standards. If changes need to be made the committee will collect evidence and present it to the board. This committee will be referred to as the Strategic Planning and Standards Committee.
- Valoria Burch began Training portion of meeting. Explained that as the new NCAAE Board our purpose is to be the voice of Alternative Education. Burch outlined how meetings should be conducted. Must have an agenda, the President will start all meetings, approve minutes from previous meetings, conduct a treasure's report, Membership committee will give a report (rosters, regional updates), Publicity Committee will report on website, Conference committee will also give report.
- President Johnson and Valoria Burch then proposed to assign board member to the required committees. The committees are: Conference, Publicity, National Connection, Strategic Planning and Standards, Membership. *Please see table below in regards to committee assignments*.
- President Johnson recommends Vice President Callie Hammound should serve as ex officio of all committees. Vice President agreed with recommendation.
- President Johnson clarified the National Connection: These people will stay connected to the National standards. Make sure NC is staying inline with National standards, provide National conference reports, etc.
- Publicity Board Member Mitchell Rapp will create some type of Committee Report Template that can be access through the NCAAE website.
- Vice President, Callie Hammound, volunteered Lee County to host the Summer Meeting. Friday, June 21st from 11 a.m. - 2 p.m. More information to come on exact location. Both Callie Hammound and

Kate Faw offered board members a place to stay the night before the meeting.

- President Johnson Green makes a motion to set membership dues at \$25.00. Kate Faw moved to approve motion, Robbie Gupton seconded the motion, motion carried unanimously.
